What is QuickFind Main Line?

LoJack® SafetyNet™ brought to you by QuickFind Main Line is a locate and rescue program available through the Lower Merion Township Police Department.

It is designed to protect local residents living with Alzheimer's, autism, or developmental disabilities that could cause them to wander or become lost.

How does it work?



Upon enrollment, your loved one is provided with a Personal Locator Unit (PLU) worn on the wrist or ankle.



Should your loved one wander or go missing, immediately contact your local police authorities. Law enforcement and public safety personnel are trained to use LoJack® SafetyNet™ Search and Rescue Receivers to track the radio signal emitted from your loved one's Personal Locator Unit.



Your loved one is quickly located and returned home safely.

The Best Technology

The Personal Locator Unit's Radio Frequency (RF) technology works in areas where GPS or cellular technology is limited or unavailable, such as wooded areas, subways, buildings, basements, concrete structures, or during inclement weather. The RF device has strong, reliable signals that can penetrate any physical obstruction.
